Kristen Biehl is an Assistant Professor at Sabancı University Faculty of Arts and Social Sciences and a researcher at Sabancı University Gender and Women's Studies Center of Excellence (SU Gender). She holds a D.Phil in Social and Cultural Anthropology from the University of Oxford. Her research interests range from examining ethnographically processes of change and practices of co-existence in urban contexts of migration, to exploring the impact of different social integration and cohesion policies and programs for refugees in Turkey. For close to 15 years she has been involved both academically and professionally in research within the migration and asylum field in Turkey. Her research has been published in peer-reviewed academic journals, including Ethnic and Racial Studies and Social Analysis, as well as various edited volumes. In this context, she has also worked closely with a great range of international, national and local actors working with different migrant and refugee communities in Turkey.
