She has worked on the impact evaluation of several social, education, and health-related projects and currently leads a research lab on evaluation at Koç University. Her research interests are (1) testing which components of interventions work or do not work in order to make the programs more cost- and outcome- effective; (2) developing novel quasi-experimental methods to evaluate programs and policies; (3) implementing models to maximize intervention effectiveness; and (4) transportability and adaptability studies to bring evidence-based programs to countries different from where they originated. She is a recipient of 2017 Young Scientist Award given by Science Academy in Turkey. She completed her post-doc in impact evaluation at Northwestern University Institute for Policy Research and PhD in Quantitative Research Methods at Arizona State University.
